

At Calvary

1. Prior to coming to Christ, did you spend years in vanity and pride? **I did (Ephesians 4:17-19; cf. Proverbs 22:8). However, can everyone say that? Isn't it important that we believe, understand, and tell the truth when we sing to God in worship (I Corinthians 14:15)?**
2. Prior to being in Christ, did you not care that He was crucified? **I didn't care about Christ at all (II Corinthians 5:14-16). However, can everyone say that?**
3. In those years of vanity and pride, did you not realize Christ died for you at Calvary? **I didn't (I Peter 1:13-14). However, can everyone say that?**
4. Did you learn of your sins through the word of God? **Yes, (I Corinthians 15:1-3, James 4:17, I John 3:4, and I John 5:17; cf. Romans 1:16-17).**
5. Did you tremble when you found you spurned God's law? **Yes, (John 12:48 and Hebrews 10:31; 12:28-29).**
6. Did your guilty soul imploring turn to Calvary? **Yes, I pleaded earnestly to our Lord and entreated Him to forgive me of my sins through the blood of His Son shed at Calvary (Acts 8:22; cf. Matthew 26:28).**
7. Have you now given to Jesus everything, having Him gladly to be your King? **Yes, (John 12:25-26, Colossians 3:1-4, and I Timothy 6:14-15).**
8. Can your raptured soul now only sing of Calvary? **No, I sing about much more that God has blessed me with (James 1:17). We sing of Heaven, joy, faith, work, etc...**
9. What love drew salvation's plan? **God's love for us (Titus 3:1-4 and I John 4:8-10).**
10. Explain the grace that brought salvation's plan down to man. **Ephesians 2:1-10!**
11. What gulf did God span at Calvary? **God made it possible for man to bridge the gap between himself and God that was started by sin at Calvary (Isaiah 59:1-2 and Romans 5:12-19).**
12. Was mercy great and grace free at Calvary? **No, the cost was the life of Christ (I Timothy 2:5-6). It was a "free gift", maybe that would be the right wording (Romans 5:15-18).**
13. Was pardon multiplied to you at Calvary? **Pardon was not performed for me at Calvary. Pardon was performed to me when I came up out of the waters of baptism after having heard the Gospel, believed it, repented of my sins, and confessed the Lord (Acts 2:37-41; 8:25-38).**
14. Did your burdened soul find liberty at Calvary? **I find liberty through what Christ did at Calvary (Galatians 5:1).**
15. Are there any scriptural objections you have to singing this song in worship to God? **Yes, the song cannot be sung by all (#'s 1-3). Also, there are wording issues in #'s 8, 12, 13, and 14.**
