

Lead Me To Calvary

1. Explain why we should or should not sing this song in worship to God (**use Scriptures to support your statements**).

- Christ is the King whether you crown Him or accept Him (**I Timothy 6:14-15**; cf. **John 18:37**).
- Jesus will not lead us to Calvary to keep us from forgetting His thorn-crowned brow (**II Timothy 3:16-17**; cf. **John 16:13** and **I Corinthians 2:9-13**). We have to look at the Scriptures not to forget (**I Corinthians 15:1-4**, **James 1:25**, and **II Peter 3:1-2**).
- The Scriptures show us the tomb where Jesus laid (**Matthew 27:59-60**). Again, Jesus will not directly show us these things. Think about this, if Jesus shows us the things we are forgetting, how can anyone ever be lost? Wouldn't Jesus then prevent apostasy (**II Peter 1:9**) and take the choice of being saved out of your hands (**Acts 2:40** and **Philippians 2:12**).
- The angels didn't guard Jesus while He slept (**Matthew 28:4; 12-15**). The angels appeared as messengers after Jesus arose (**Luke 24:4-6**).
- How can we come to the tomb of Jesus like Mary with a gift today? Jesus is risen and He has ascended into Heaven (**Acts 1:9-11**).
- Asking to see the empty tomb is asking to see rather than believe (**John 20:27-31** and **II Corinthians 5:7**; cf. **Hebrews 1:1**).

2. Whether this whole song is scriptural or not, what can we learn from examining this song (**use Scriptures to support your statements**)?

- Glory should be to Christ (**Galatians 6:14** and **Hebrews 13:21**).
- We need to study and constantly reflect on what Jesus did for us and how much He suffered for us (**Ephesians 2:11-13**).
- We should be willing to bear our daily cross for Christ and to share in His sufferings because of what He did for us (**Luke 9:23-24**, **Philippians 1:29-30; 3:10-11**, and **I Peter 2:20-21; 4:1; 4:13**).
- We should not forget Gethsemane either when we think of the mental anguish our Lord suffered for us (**Matthew 26:36-45**; cf. **Hebrews 5:7**).
- How can we forget the Love Christ has for us (**I John 3:16**)?

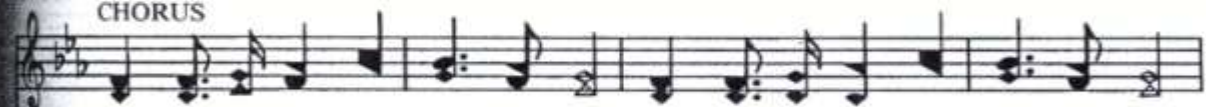
