I. Introduction:

- A. This lesson has nothing to do with the modern day state of Israel, but rather Israel of Old that once were God's chosen people (**Exodus 19:1-6** and **II Samuel 7:23-24**).
 - 1. Meaning, the direct descendants of Jacob who was called Israel (**Genesis 32:28**).
 - 2. Jacob and Israel are interchangeable terms for his descendants (**Isaiah 10:20** and **Isaiah 14:1**).
- B. It is easy for us to discount them because they "blew it" many times (Deuteronomy 9:7, Deuteronomy 9:24, Deuteronomy 31:25-27, Jeremiah 32:30, Ezekiel 20:28-32, and Acts 7:50-53). *Judah (Hebrews 7:14) was a decedent of Jacob, part of Israel (Genesis 43:8), but were divided from the days of Rehoboam son of Solomon and Jeroboam son of Nebat (I Kings 12:1-33).
 - 1. Don't forget God's view of their value (**Deuteronomy 7:6-8**, **Deuteronomy 10:15**, **Hosea 11:1**, and **Malachi 1:1-5**).
 - 2. Jesus' showed this love (Matthew 23:37).
- II. Body: There Are Things That Belong To The Peace Of Israel Of Old (Luke 19:41-44).
 - A. Unto them was committed the oracles of God (**Romans 3:1-2**).
 - 1. They were given the word (**Psalms 147:19-20**).
 - 2. They were trusted to pass it forward (**Psalms 78:5-8**).
 - B. God did not cast them away (**Psalms 94:14-15**).
 - 1. The New Testament didn't change that (**Romans 11:1-5**).
 - 2. Actually, God's intention was that the New Testament would lead to their complete restoration to Him (**Jeremiah 31:31-34**, **Hebrews 8:1-13**, and **Hebrews 10:1-18**).
 - 3. Jesus sought them first (Matthew 15:24 and Luke 19:1-10).
 - 4. They had first priority with the Gospel of Christ (**Matthew 10:5-6** and **Acts 3:13-26**).
 - 5. The Gentiles were not preached to until some time after the church was established (**Acts 10:1-11:18**), even though such was God's intention all along (**Genesis 22:18**, **Mark 16:15-16**, and **Acts 2:38-39**).

- C. Understand that without Israel, and their place, there is no salvation for US today (**Romans 11:11-24**).
 - 1. While the law and prophets were until John (**Luke 16:16**), the prophets still serve as part of our foundation (**Ephesians 2:11-22**).
 - 2. They were given the law, the promises, and they gave us Jesus (**Romans 9:1-5**).
