Assembling Together Is An Essential Activity

I. Introduction:

- A. Our government denies the essentiality of the assembling of the saints because the world doesn't get it (Hosea 8:11-12 and I Corinthians 2:14).

 B. Doing God's will is essential [absolutely necessary; extremely important] (Luke 6:46, Luke 11:28, Colossians 1:10, and I Thessalonians 4:1-2).
 - 1. What is necessary (Titus 3:8; 14)?
 - 2. Even if the authorities of this world say otherwise (**Acts 4:8-20**; **5:26-29**).
 - 3. Doing the will of God is essential for salvation (I John 2:15-17).
- II. Body: We Must Continue To Come Together Even Under Distress (**John 20:19**, **Acts 4:19-23**, and **Hebrews 10:22-25**).
 - A. Collective worship is essential (Acts 2:42; 20:7).
 - 1. Communion [joint participation; fellowship] is collective (I Corinthians 10:16-17).
 - 2. Worship TOGETHER is necessary for various reasons (I Corinthians 11:33, Ephesians 4:16, Colossians 3:16, etc.).
 - B. Even in the face of danger, being together is essential (Acts 12:1-19 and Acts 14:19-28).
 - 1. In addition to worship (I Thessalonians 5:11-14).
 - 2. Our service to God includes edifying one another (Romans 14:19).
 - 3. We should desire to see one another (I Thessalonians 2:17).
 - C. Even Heaven will be about us being together (II Thessalonians 2:1).
 - 1. With each other and our Lord (I Thessalonians 4:13-18; 5:10).
 - 2. Like Jesus, we should want to be where the saints are (**John 12:26** and **John 14:1-3**).
- III. Conclusion: Let's continue to stand TOGETHER (**Philippians 1:27**).
