## **Consent Thou Not**

- I. Introduction: When I was a child the slogan against drugs was "just say no." Well, what about sin in general?
  - A. Good parents instruct children (**Proverbs 1:8**) so they can have better lives (**Proverbs 3:1-2**).
    - 1. We work so that our children can find favor [acceptance] with God and man (**Proverbs 3:4**).
    - 2. We teach the good and right ways to live (Proverbs 4:1-13).
    - 3. Part of those instructions are to avoid the paths of the wicked (**Proverbs 4:14-17**).
  - B. Well folks, God is our Father (Ephesians 4:6).
    - 1. His instructions are to our benefit carnally and spiritually (**Psalms 1:1-3**, **Psalms 119:97-101**, **Proverbs 2:6**, and **Acts 20:32**).
    - 2. Like a good parent, He knows the dangers of influence in our lives (**Proverbs 13:20** and **I Corinthians 15:33**).
- II. Body: So... Proverbs 1:10
  - A. Sinners are those outside of God's people (**Psalms 1:5**) whom are transgressors of the will of God (**Isaiah 1:4** and **I John 3:4**).
    - 1. The Lord draws a really clear distinction (I John 3:7-10).
    - 2. Those that want to continue in sin won't hear the truth (John 8:43-47).
    - 3. So, don't abuse the idea of being a light to the world (Matthew 5:14-16).
  - B. Who is influencing who? Don't be a conformer (Romans 12:1-2)?
    - 1. The word translated "entice" in **Proverbs 1:10** is also translated "deceived" (**Deuteronomy 11:16**), "persuade" (**I Kings 22:20-22**), "flatter" (**Psalms 78:36**), "allure" (**Hosea 2:14**), etc. Think about that!
    - 2. Sinners are deceptive and will true to allure you into sinful behaviors (**Psalms 28:3** and **Proverbs 26:22-28**).
      - a. Don't be naive (Proverbs 14:15 and Jeremiah 12:6).
      - b. Understand the consequences of sin are not removed just because someone tricked you (**Ephesians 5:6**).
    - 3. Don't be deceived, it only takes one sinner to bring about much harm (**Ecclesiastes 9:18**).
  - C. Don't be a willing participant. Don't consent. Refuse (Genesis 39:1-12)!
    - 1. Hate it (**Psalms 101:1-7**).
    - 2. Be the strange one (I Peter 4:1-5).
- III. Conclusion: Proverbs 4:18-27
