

# For If Ye Do These Things Ye Shall Never Fall

(Part 12)

## I. Introduction:

A. We have been focused on things we need to grow in so that we never fall in our past 11 lessons (**II Peter 1:1-9**) for a reason...

1. Few will be saved (**Luke 13:23-24**).
2. Many who start in Christ fall away (**Matthew 22:14, Luke 8:4-15, John 6:60-66, and Revelation 2:1-3:22**).

B. We have to ask ourselves if we want eternal life badly enough to put in the necessary work to obtain it (**I Corinthians 9:24-27** and **James 1:12**)?

1. Finishing faithful is no “walk in the park” (**Acts 14:22**).
2. It doesn’t take much to fall (**James 2:10-12**).
3. Don’t run so far and it all be for nothing (**Ezekiel 18:24**).

## II. Body: Diligently Do Those Things To Never Fall (**II Peter 1:10-11**).

A. Wherefore the rather [more (in a greater degree); Strong’s # 3123] give diligence [“to use speed, i.e. to make effort, be prompt or earnest”; Strong’s #4704] to make your calling and election sure (**Hebrews 12:1-17**).

1. In other words, let us labor; get to work (**Hebrews 3:15-4:11**).
2. Be diligent to be found ready (**II Peter 3:9-14**; cf. **Matthew 25:1-13**).
3. Your calling, vocation (**Ephesians 4:1-6**).
4. Your election [chosen] (**II Thessalonians 2:13-17**).
5. Sure [steadfast; stable; firm;] (**Hebrews 3:6; 14**).
6. In all of this, realize that it is YOU that has the control over your calling and election being sure (**II John 1:8**).

B. “If YE do these things...” Preventing falling away by following God’s way (**John 5:24-29**).

1. Following the proper instructions (**Acts 20:32** and **I Thessalonians 2:1-12**).
2. Not being influenced by the erring (**Colossians 2:6-8; 20-23**).
3. We need to continue in obedience (**John 8:31-32, Romans 11:22, II Corinthians 10:1-5, II Timothy 3:14-17, and I John 2:24**).
4. You can finish faithful (**II Timothy 4:6-8**; cf. **I Corinthians 11:1**).

C. Abundantly [richly] ministered [supplied; furnished] an entrance into the everlasting kingdom (**Matthew 25:31-46**).

1. The Good Shepherd is the one supplying us with everlasting life (**John 10:1-18; John 14:6**).
2. That life is there for your taking (**Romans 6:22** and **Hebrews 10:36**).
