Grace Teaches Us...

I. Introduction:

- A. God's grace to us is through Christ (John 1:14-17 and II Timothy 2:1).
 - 1. For Christians, we understand that our justification came through the grace of Christ (**Romans 3:24**) as planned long ago (**II Timothy 1:8-10**).
 - 2. We [saints] understand that our hope is through grace (II Thessalonians 2:16).
- B. The grace that saves had a heavy price (Hebrews 2:8-9).
 - 1. Grace is supposed to save us (Ephesians 2:1-10).
 - 2. Seeing these things, let's [disciples of Christ] not receive the grace of God through Christ in vain (II Corinthians 6:1).
- II. Body: Apply What Grace Teaches Us (Titus 2:11-14)!
 - A. Denying [refuse] ungodliness and worldly lusts (Romans 6:1-6, Ephesians 4:22-23, and I Thessalonians 4:7).
 - 1. Don't tie yourself to the ungodly (II Corinthians 6:14-7:1).
 - 2. Put your desires in the right place (I Peter 2:1-11).
 - B. Live soberly, righteously, and godly in this present world (I Peter 1:13-17).
 - 1. Not self-righteously (Romans 10:1-3).
 - 2. Be sure to be in, but not OF the world (**John 17:14-17**, **Romans 12:1-2**, and **I John 4:1-6**; **5:19-20**).
 - 3. Don't just talk the talk either (I John 2:3-6).
 - C. Looking for Christ to come again (II Peter 3:1-14).
 - 1. He is our hope (II Thessalonians 2:13-17).
 - 2. He is our Savior (I John 4:14).
 - 3. Our salvation will be realized at His return (I Peter 1:1-9).
 - D. He died to redeem us and to purify us as His people (**Colossians 1:12-23**).
 - 1. You've been redeemed from iniquity, don't turn back to it (II Peter 2:20-22).
 - 2. You've been purified, so keep yourself pure (I John 3:1-3).
 - 3. Be a peculiar [beyond usual; special] person (**Psalms 4:3**).

- 4. Be zealous of good works (**Titus 3:8**; **14**).
- 5. Be ready when He returns (Matthew 24:44-51).

III. Conclusion: Let's be good stewards of the manifold grace of God (I Peter 4:10-11).
