Having A Basic Understanding of Some Old Testament Truths

Part 133 – A Wise Son Through Keeping Instruction (Proverbs 10:1-17)

1. What is the difference between a wise son and a foolish son?

"The proverbs of Solomon. <u>A wise son maketh a glad father</u>: but <u>a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother</u>" (**Proverbs 10:1**).

- * The wise son makes parents glad (**Proverbs 15:20**, **Proverbs 23:15-16**, **Proverbs 23:24-25**, and **Proverbs 29:3**).
- * The parents of a fool have no joy (**Proverbs 17:21**, **Proverbs 17:25**, and **Proverbs 19:13**).
- * Parents are not without blame when it comes to a child being foolish: "The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame" (Proverbs 29:15).
- 2. Are the treasures of wickedness profitable?

No: "Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but righteousness delivereth from death" (Proverbs 10:2).

- * Wealth won't save anyone (Psalms 49:6-10 and Proverbs 11:4).
- * Rather than deliverance, wealth often becomes a death trap (Luke 12:15-21 and I Timothy 6:6-10).
- * Righteousness delivers from death (Proverbs 12:28 and I Peter 4:18).
- 3. Will the righteous suffer to starve [famish]?

No: "The LORD will not suffer the soul of the righteous to famish: but he casteth away the substance of the wicked" (**Proverbs 10:3**).

- * The righteous will never starve (**Psalms 37:25**, **Luke 12:22-31**, and **Hebrews 13:5-6**).
- * God's NOW (in a time when miracles have ceased) provides naturally (Matthew 5:45, Acts 14:17, and Hebrews 6:7) and through our brethren (Acts 4:32-37 and Romans 15:25-27).
- 4. Is it wise to be a lazy slacker?

No: "(4) He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich. (5) He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame" (**Proverbs 10:4-5**).

* Proverbs 6:6-11, Proverbs 12:24, Proverbs 19:15; 24, Proverbs 20:4, Proverbs 20:13, and Hebrews 6:11-12.

- 5. In comparing the just and the wicked, who is really blessed?
 - "(6) <u>Blessings are upon the head of the just</u>: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked. (7) <u>The memory of the just is blessed</u>: but the name of the wicked shall rot" (**Proverbs 10:6-7**).
 - * The just are blessed (**Deuteronomy 28:2** and **Proverbs 28:20**).
 - * The just will be remembered above the wicked (Ecclesiastes 7:1; cf. Mark 4:3-9).
- 6. What type of person receives commandments?

"The wise in heart will receive commandments: but a prating fool shall fall" (**Proverbs** 10:8).

- * The wise are receptive (Proverbs 9:9 and Proverbs 21:11).
- * The foolish reject knowledge and will fall (**Proverbs 1:7**).
- 7. Do those that pervert their ways walk surely?

No: "<u>He that walketh uprightly walketh surely</u>: but he that perverteth his ways shall be known" (**Proverbs 10:9**).

- * "Whoso walketh uprightly shall be saved: but he that is perverse in his ways shall fall at once" (Proverbs 28:18).
- 8. What does the winking of the eye cause?

"He that winketh with the eye causeth sorrow: but a prating fool shall fall" (**Proverbs** 10:10).

- * Diotrephes is an example of a prating fool (III John 9-11).
- 9. What is the mouth of a righteous man?

"The mouth of a righteous man is a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked" (**Proverbs 10:11**).

- * Psalms 37:30-31, Proverbs 15:7, Proverbs 16:23-24, and Proverbs 18:4.
- 10. What is the difference between hatred and love?

"Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins" (**Proverbs 10:12**).

- * The reason love covers sin is here: **Proverbs 17:9** and **James 5:19-20**; cf. **Revelation 3:19**.
- 11. What is intended for the back of him that is void of understanding?

"In the lips of him that hath understanding wisdom is found: but a rod is for the back of him that is void of understanding" (**Proverbs 10:13**).

* Proverbs 26:3

12. What do wise men lay up?

"Wise men lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the foolish is near destruction" (**Proverbs 10:14**).

- * Proverbs 1:5, Proverbs 9:9, and Proverbs 19:8.
- 13. What is the strong city of a rich man?

His wealth: "The rich man's wealth is his strong city: the destruction of the poor is their poverty" (**Proverbs 10:15**).

- * Psalms 49:6-7, Jeremiah 9:23, and I Timothy 6:17.
- 14. Are the righteous and the wicked working to get to the same end?

 No: "The labour of the righteous tendeth to life: the fruit of the wicked to sin"

 (Proverbs 10:16).
 - * "Say ye to the righteous, that it shall be well with him: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings. Woe unto the wicked! it shall be ill with him: for the reward of his hands shall be given him" (Isaiah 3:10-11).
- 15. What do those of us in the way of life need to keep?

"He is in the way of life that keepeth instruction: but he that refuseth reproof erreth" (**Proverbs 10:17**).
