Our Toolbox During Times Of Adversity

I. Introduction:

- A. This week we have seen spiritual death, near physical death, ungodly departures, the faithful afflicted, sleepless night, etc. All of that is a lot to bear and so we should expect of life in this world (**Psalms 90:10**).
- B. We need to understand that our Lord "gets it" regarding what we face in this life we live on earth (Isaiah 53:3, and Hebrews 4:14-16; 5:5-9).
 - 1. He knows the disappointment of loved ones falling away and the wish that you could have prevented it (Matthew 23:37 and Luke 19:41-44).
 - 2. He knows the sorrows pertaining to losses in the flesh (**John 11:1-3**; **14**; **28-36**).
- II. Body: Peace Is Available, At All Times, If You'll Let It Be (Colossians 3:15).
 - A. God has supplied us with the right words of peace (II Peter 1:1-4).
 - 1. Even when we must take difficult actions (II Thessalonians 3:6-16).
 - 2. All we have to do is think on and follow the right ways to have that peace (**Psalms 119:165**, **Proverbs 3:1-8**, and **Philippians 4:6-9**).
 - 3. Each of us need to live aright so that, if we become gravely ill and pass, the words of comfort will be easy to find (I Thessalonians 4:13-18).
 - B. God has supplied us with a support system on earth (**Proverbs 17:17**, **Colossians 4:7-12**, and **I Thessalonians 5:11**).
 - 1. The faithful will "have your back" (I Samuel 18:1-4, I Samuel 19:1-6, II Samuel 1:25-26, Acts 9:23-25, and Romans 16:1-4).
 - 2. The faithful will follow the unselfish example of Jesus (**John 13:34-35**; **15:12-13**, and **I John 4:7-11**).
 - C. God has supplied us with an everlasting place of peace to press towards (**John 14:1-3**).
 - 1. We need to live not only as though we could die at any moment, but that Jesus could return and we get out of this miserable world to a place, if faithful, much better (**Matthew 24:35-25:46**).
 - 2. Focus on "eternal life" (I John 2:24-25).
 - 3. My brother in Christ, my son in the flesh, when deserted by his wife this week said: "I am going to just focus on things above" HOW TRUE (Colossians 3:1-4)!
