

Remember His Marvelous Works

I. Introduction:

A. In Elihu's words of correction to Job, He told Job to stand still and consider the wondrous works of God (**Job 37:14**).

1. In Elihu's words, he talked of God's greatness (**Job 36:24-37:1**).
2. In Elihu's words, he talked of the power of God's words (**Job 37:2-13**).
3. In Elihu's words, he talked of why men fear God (**Job 37:15-24**).
4. Remembering who we serve is of great importance (**Isaiah 40:28**).

B. Israel's lack of remembrance led them to err (**Psalms 78:40-42**).

1. It was said that they forgot His works (**Psalms 78:10-11**).
2. Their forgetting didn't take long (**Psalms 106:13**).
3. We don't want to be them (**Zechariah 1:4-6**).

II. Body: **Psalms 77:11, Psalms 105:1-5, Psalms 111:4, and Psalms 143:5**

A. Remember what the Lord has done is key to being thankful and mindful of His will (**I Chronicles 16:8-26**).

1. It is beneficial to us to be thankful for things present (**Philippians 4:6-8** and **Colossians 3:15-17**).
2. Thanksgiving is beneficial for things in the past (**Psalms 106:1-48**).
3. Thanksgiving is also beneficial in looking forward (**I Corinthians 15:57**).

B. Remember the former things of old (**Deuteronomy 32:7, Isaiah 46:9-11, and Romans 15:4**).

1. For the purpose of knowing that God does what He said [says] He will do (**Isaiah 42:8-9**; cf. **Joshua 23:14-15**).
2. To stand in awe (**Psalms 4:4**) and understand His greatness (**Jeremiah 5:22**).
3. To remember where'd we'd be without Him (**Ephesians 2:11-19**).

C. When we consider our Creator, we know very well that we are wonderfully made (**Psalms 139:14**).

1. Consider that we are the offspring of God (**Acts 17:24-29**).
2. When you look up to the sky, think about Him (**Psalms 8:1-5** [cf. **Hebrews 2:5-8**], **Psalms 19:1**, and **Isaiah 40:22-26**).
3. When you consider the continuation of God's natural providence (**Acts 14:17**).
4. When you think of unanswerable questions (**Ecclesiastes 3:11**; cf. **Romans 11:33-36**).
5. With all of that, ponder what we [faithful saints] shall be (**I John 3:1-3**).
6. The best is yet to come (**Colossians 1:5-6** and **I Peter 1:3-4**).

III. Conclusion: Think about what the Lord said to Abraham (**Genesis 17:1**).
