Some Really Good News

I. Introduction:

- A. Good news is refreshing (**Proverbs 25:25**).
 - 1. Like when you hear something good about someone you may be concerned about (**II Corinthians 2:13** and **II Corinthians 7:6-7**).
 - 2. Like when you hear about the faithfulness of others (III John 1:4).
 - 3. Sadly, the best news we can get in this world is still only temporary. That is human life in general (**Psalms 39:5-6**).
- B. The world doesn't offer peace (**John 16:33**).
 - 1. On the other hand... II Thessalonians 3:16
 - 2. We have our part to play too though (**Psalms 119:165**, **Isaiah 26:3**, and **Colossians 3:15**).
 - 3. If we <u>focus</u> on the reports we see and hear in the world, our minds will be troubled and those anxieties can choke the real good news (**Mark 4:19**).
- II. Body: So, Let's Think About Some Really Good News (Isaiah 40:9, Isaiah 52:4-9, and Romans 10:11-17).
 - A. This good news comes from Jesus (Isaiah 61:1-3; cf. Luke 4:16-21).
 - 1. Think about what John said when He saw Jesus (John 1:29; 3:35-36).
 - 2. The declaration of the true "glad tidings" comes to what Jesus means for mankind (**Acts 13:32-39**).
 - 3. We can escape fear because Jesus has abolished death and has brought immortality to light through the Gospel (**II Timothy 1:7-12**).
 - a. We can pass from death to life (John 5:24-29).
 - b. So, don't discount that "like precious faith" (II Peter 1:1).
 - B. The good news from Jesus allows us to rethink things in hope rather than despair (I Thessalonians 4:13-18).
 - 1. That hope does not happen without Christ (**Ephesians 2:11-12**).
 - 2. That hope allows us to look at the bad stuff, like physical death, differently (Romans 5:12-21 and I Peter 1:13).
 - 3. The worst is only temporary (I Peter 5:5-10).
 - C. Being faithful allows us to absorb bad news (Psalms 112:5-8).
 - 1. We have someone we can trust in (Psalms 56:3-4).
 - 2. Think about what was said to those who were going to be alive during the destruction of Jerusalem (Luke 21:5-19).
 - 3. On the other hand, think of how the unfaithful process such bad news (**Jeremiah 6:21-25**).
- III. Conclusion: Please, REMEMBER the really good news (I John 4:14).
