I. Introduction:

A. Jesus would tell the erring that those known to be sinners had a better chance of being in Heaven than those who thought they were good (**Matthew 21:23-32**).

1. In part, such statements were made because those of us who have sinned greatly appreciate the chance of salvation (**Luke 7:36-50**).

2. In part, such statements were made because those whom choose to be blind have ZERO chance of being saved (**Acts 28:26-27**).

3. There are unfaithful standards we must be better than (Matthew 5:20).

B. How "good" is the end for the devils (Matthew 25:41)?

1. Could one appearing to be a follower of Christ really be a devil in disguise (**John 6:60-71**)?

- 2. What would it take for you to be considered as a devil (I John 3:8-10)?
- II. Body: The Devils Believe And Tremble (James 2:19).
  - A. They obeyed the authority of Christ (Luke 10:17).
    - 1. Man has long rejected Christ (Luke 9:22 and Luke 20:9-19).

2. We read and even sing a song about doing all by the authority of Christ (**Colossians 3:16-17**).

3. As we read the devils believed and trembled (**James 2:19**), let our obedience be fueled by <u>more than</u> just fear (**II Corinthians 5:14-15** and **Ephesians 6:24**).

4. They were subject by force (**Mark 3:14-15**). Let us be obedient by choice and proper excitement (**Psalms 40:8**).

- B. They were willing to acknowledge the truth (Acts 16:16-18).
  - 1. They knew and acknowledged Christ (Mark 3:11).
  - 2. Men have not been so willing to do so (I John 2:18-19; 22).
  - 3. We need keep ourselves in the right (I John 2:23-26).
- C. They would not listen to false teachers (Acts 19:11-16).
  - 1. Man is not so careful (Jeremiah 5:31; 6:15-17 and II Timothy 4:1-5).
  - 2. We must be on guard (Proverbs 19:27 and Ephesians 5:6).
- D. They understood their time was coming (Matthew 8:28-34).
  - 1. Men downplay the coming judgment (II Peter 3:1-14; cf. Eccl. 8:11).
  - 2. Are you ready (Mark 13:32-37)?

III. Conclusion: Listen up.... They had "it" but gave "it" up (**Jude 1:6**). Don't give "it" up as they did (**Hebrews 10:35-39** and **II John 1:8**)! \*It - A home in Heaven.
