The Lord's Definition Of A Believer

I. Introduction:

- A. The Lord doesn't look on man as man does (I Samuel 16:7 and Luke 16:15).
 - 1. The Lord's thinking is not defined by us (Isaiah 55:7-9).
 - 2. Our thoughts need to be defined by Him (Psalms 37:23 and Proverbs 3:5-7).
- B. We must remember that the Lord views things as either/or (Luke 11:23).
 - 1. He says do it or don't, but there is no middle ground (Revelation 3:14-16).
 - 2. God says choose (I Kings 18:21).
 - 3. The Lord sees doers of His word or not, He does not see some idea of inbetweeners (Matthew 6:24, I Corinthians 10:21, and I John 3:8-10).
- II. Body: God differentiates between believers and unbelievers based on action (**Luke 6:46-49**).
 - A. A believer has a Greek dictionary definition (as used in **I Timothy 4:12**): "trustworthy; subjectively, trustful:--believe(-ing, -r), faithful(-ly), sure, true" (Strong's # 4103).
 - 1. God's definition of faith: "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen... But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Hebrews 11:1; 6).
 - a. Faith is what moves us to please God (**Hebrews 11:5**; **7**).
 - b. Faith works by what (Galatians 5:6)?
 - c. How is love proven (John 14:15)?
 - d. Can a person without Christ claim to have hope which is the substance of faith (**Ephesians 2:12**)?
 - 2. Faith must be obtained (II Peter 1:1), continued in (John 8:30-31 and Acts 14:21-22), and put to continuous use (Titus 3:14).
 - 3. An example of believers is found in those who receive and do the word of God (I Thessalonians 1:3-10).
 - B. There is a difference between saying God exists and being a believer (**James 2:14-26**).
 - 1. Being a believer is about action (James 1:19-27).
 - 2. Just because people show interest, become fascinated, etc.; that does not mean they believe (Mark 6:1-6).

- 3. Some "followers" of Jesus were unbelievers (John 6:60-64).
- C. Because they believed not (Psalms 78:1-32).
 - 1. This lesson applies to us (Hebrews 3:1-4:3).
 - 2. The word WORKS on true believers (I Thessalonians 2:13).
