The Softer Side Of Saints

I. Introduction:

- A. The term "saint" is simply another term for any faithful Christian, disciple of the Lord, etc. (I Corinthians 1:2).
- B. Since we are discussing the soft side of Christians, I am inferring there is another side, <u>likened unto God</u> (**Romans 11:22**; cf. **Numbers 14:18**).
 - 1. God wants to show His giving, friendly side (Luke 12:32).
 - 2. What side you get depends on you (I Chronicles 28:9).
 - 3. With proper understanding, we are to pattern our lives after God (**Ephesians 5:1-2**).
 - 4. Thus, what side people see in us will often depend on them (**Psalms 101:3**).
- II. Body: The Softer Side Of Saints (I Peter 3:8).
 - A. Compassion [sympathy] one of another (**Romans 12:15** and **I Corinthians 12:25-26**).
 - 1. For example, consider Jesus (Matthew 9:36-38, Matthew 15:32, and John 11:32-33).
 - 2. This requires KNOWING and CARING about each other enough to do something when we can (I John 3:14-18).
 - B. Love as brethren (Romans 12:10 and Hebrews 13:1).
 - 1. Jesus gave the pattern (**John 13:34-35**; **15:12-13**).
 - 2. This love has to be sincere (I Peter 1:22).
 - 3. Our love for brethren, while being second only to our love for God, is not limited to just brethren (Matthew 5:44-48, Luke 10:25-37, and Romans 13:8-10).
 - C. Pity (Matthew 18:21-35).
 - 1. The Lord gives the pattern (Psalms 103:13 and James 5:11).
 - 2. The word "pity" is also translated "tenderhearted", as such we have our lesson laid out for us (**Ephesians 4:31-32**).
 - D. Courteous [friendly; kind] (**Proverbs 18:24**).
 - 1. As the elect of God, we are to be kind amongst other things (Colossians 3:12; cf. II Peter 1:7).

2. Even the world has some understanding of what THEY often call the "Golden Rule" (Matthew 7:12).

III. Conclusion: Saints are NOT just about love and friendliness (**Romans 12:9**). *This will be discussed more in our next lesson. There is another side to the points we have discussed above.
